Ana Barriga, the new queen of pop art and the success of her cat Laki

The young Ana Barriga can be considered the new queen of pop, and *Laki*, her most important and promising work so far. A cat that will give a lot to comment, because in addition to her disdainful smile, she hunts mice. Barriga had been devoting herself, with excellent results, to painting, but she has broken the deck and has said: here I stand, either we take the cat for a walk or we ask Luis de la Pica to sing some bulerías for us: as the latter is complex, let's do the former!

Ana Barriga is from Jerez de la Frontera, 1984, and before being a queen she was a princess, a nereid on the back of a hippocampus. And before making flipar she became a superior technician in Furniture Design and Applied Arts. She graduated in Fine Arts at the University of Seville and to top it off, Master of Art, Idea and Production. In other words, she arrives at glamour very well prepared, well equipped and demanding, neat and ready, smelling clean.
